Each year is sprinkled with a range of festivals, such as The Dreaming Festival in June, a showcase of indigenous arts from around the world. At some of these festivals, you can take your tent, set up camp and fall asleep with the music as the background to your dreams.

My favourite kind of Sunday afternoon, after swimming and a leisurely lunch, is to dance barefoot on the grass at 'Peregian Originals', a free open-air community concert in the park behind the surf club at Peregian Beach. They have an interesting selection of musicians and styles of music. You will also find some diverse music by local talent performed at the Eumundi Markets. And just in case you feel inclined to get creative yourself, there are some stalls selling musical instruments.
